- Building collaborative cultures in the school in order to build leadership and teacher capacity through a cycle of coaching and reflection
- Increasing the provision of technology, including adaptive technology and communication devices for students to engage in balanced literacy
- Building the capacity of teachers through professional development in order to increase student outcomes in reading and analysis and discussion or data

1. PROFESSIONAL LEARNING
 - Professional learning experiences linked to evidence based teaching practices in reading and data conversations to monitor student growth

 - Purchase of adaptive equipment, switches etc., Alternative and Augmentative Communication Systems, increase in bandwidth for increased access for all students to engage in communication and balanced literacy
